3. Fun Day Review

The P1-3 football shield and also the netball shield are full up, new shields will be purchased next year with the old ones being kept at the school. One complaint was received from a gentleman who lives in Springfield Gardens who's garden backs onto the park. Some children had been playing with equipment in his garden, a sign will be made for next year asking people to stay within the park. A sign will also be needed to let people know that the first aid kit is in the trophy van, Louise to action. Louise will also send a letter to the Park Committee booking the park for next year's gala (Sunday 18th June) in order to avoid any clash in fixtures with Buchan Ladies.
