3. Christmas Outing

Since agreeing at the AGM that the Christmas Outing would be to Aberdeen Football Club for the game against St Johnstone on the 10th of December, the Strathythan indoor league fixtures had been issued. The A league team are due to play on the 10th of December their first game being the second game of the night. Stuart will contact Colin regarding the fixtures to see if they could be changed to accommodate us, however, if this isn't possible it was thought that the children could be taken to Mintlaw directly from Pittodrie for the 6pm start. Veronica had also contacted Pittodrie to enquire about the Junior Matchday package. She was advised that a Dons Day Out would be better due to the numbers potentially going. Veronica to contact Pittodrie to confirm details/prices, Louise will get a note done to hand out to all children at the next training session. Veronica has also priced buses, this can be confirmed once final numbers received. Louise to provisionally book the parents/helpers/coaches night out at the Club's Bring a Party to a Party. Going by last year's numbers we will book 20 places, this will be added onto the note re the Christmas outing.

It had been discussed at the AGM regarding a coaches rota, Louise had issued a rota for helpers but had struggled to do one for the coaches. The coaches confirmed they were managing to sort things out amongst themselves without a rota, but this could always be re-visited if necessary.

Insurance:-

A parent had approached a committee member re a swap box for football boots/shin pads which children had outgrown but could potentially be passed on. It was felt this could be difficult as one person would have to be responsible for keeping items, storing them and then making them available at training sessions. We will not go ahead with this.

Veronica is still waiting new sample strips, she has chased up the companies but without success.
